

## Legrand Rowe and Salina Bell

- 1) On the 11th day of August, 1850, Legrand was 20 years old, working as a painter and living in Town of Harmony, Chautauqua County, New York. His last name was spelled Roe.
- 2) On the 14th day of August, 1850, Salina Bell was 13 years old and living in Pine Grove Township, in Warren County, Pa. She was with her father, Benjamin Bell, age 34, B. about 1816 in Ny., who worked as a carpenter. Also in the household:  
Mother Sarah age 31 Born in Ny.  
Siblings Charles age 7 born in Ny., William W. age 3 born in Ny., Benjamin F. age 2 born in Ny., Augustus age 1/12 born in Pa., Timothy Freeman age 82 born in Ny., Ephraim Wait age 22, born in Ny.
- 3) On the 12th day of June, 1860, Salina Bell was 23 years old and living with her family in Putnam Springfield Township, Muskingum, Ohio.  
Also in the household:  
Father Benjamin P. Bell age 50, working as a furniture finisher. Sarah S. Bell age 41, Charles age 17, Robert age 13 born in Pa., Benjamin 11, Herbert 10, Sarah E. age 7, Flora age 1/12 Margaret Secrest age 16, John McBride age 23, Henrietta McBride 23.
- 4) On the 12th day of August 1861, Legrand enlisted at Camp Burnett, Tenn in the Confederate Army as a Machinist. He was mustered in on Sept 14, 1861. He was 35 years old, 5' 10" in height, Sandy complexion, grey eyes, brown hair. Born in Otsego County, Ny.  
He became sick and was detailed to Hospital duty in Bowling Green. Ky.
- 5) On the 28th day of July 1862, Legrand was discharged from the Confederate Army at Bowling Green. It was a medical discharge for pulmonary Consumption.
- 6) In August of 1870, Legrand and Salina and two children, are living in Allegheny City, Allegheny County, Pa. Salina is 33, Legrand is 40 and working as a carpenter, Herbert is 16 born in Pa., and Robert is 1 year old born in Pa. They have a Homer (says was female, can't be Homer) Hamilton age 53, born in Pa. living with them. There are Hamiltons next door, maybe got wrong addr?
- 7) In the 1870-1871 and 1871-1872 issues of the Pittsburg City directory, Legrand is listed as being a carpenter and living at 148 Ridge Ave, in Allegheny City, Pa.
- 8) On the 14th day of June, 1900, Salina age 63 is living at The Home for Aged Protestant Women, in Wilkesburg Borough, Allegheny, Pa. She is listed there in the 1902-1904 Pittsburgh city directories. She's not listed 1905-1907.

9) Salina N. Rowe died 30 November, 1907. Buried at Homewood Cemetery.
