Facts and Timeline for Oscar Barney Albro

1850 - ? (July 1850 given date of birth as per 1900 federal census.)

1860 - ?

1870 - ?

1880 - ?

24 October, 1883 - New Lyme, Ashtabula County, Ohio - married to Miss Cleora Stone. Name given as Barney Aldro, age 21, which would make his birth year about 1862.

1900 - Federal census, Warren, Warren County, Pennsylvania, with wife Cleora and children, Oliver, Lena, Frederick, Guy and Walter.

1901 - In the Warren, Pa. city directory. carpenter, boarding at 907 4th.

1910 - not found, nor any of family

1920 - Oscar not found. Cleora found on Federal census, Jamestown, NY with sons Walter and Oliver. She is listed as widowed.

1930 - not found

Notes: In nine years of searching these are the only two places my brother and I have found our great grandfather, Oscar Barney Albro.

He was known to family as "Barney".

The family story always said Barney left Cleora and the children.

Our father, Howard, Jr. said his dad's father (Barney) left when he

(Howard, Sr.) was a young boy.. It would have been after the 1900 census.

Howard, Sr. (Frederick on census) would have been 9 or 10.

28 July, 1920 - A grandson to Oscar Barney Albro is born; named Oscar Barney Albro.

21 February, 1922 - Cleora Albro died in Cassadaga, NY. Buried in Pine Tree Cemetery, Falconer, NY. Death certificate states she is widowed. Name of spouse - Oscar Albro

Strange coincidence - Emma Farmer and Cleora Albro died the same year.
